The Following Specific Activities Have Been Accomplished During The year Under Report: 2021-22

Awareness Programme:

As per our experience and observation regarding our voluntary social service it has been seen that awareness plays a vital role in generating consciousness among the people for a cause to achieve a aspire.

Following are some steps taken by BAHARU HASIMPUR HUMAN WELFARE SOCIETY in creating realization about awaking people regarding their thoughts, to change their basic myths, ignorance and etc.

Health Programme:

The health programme was established as a home for curing the deprived and underprivileged. With encouragement from the local community, and support from well-wishers, the programme as it exists today steadily developed to become a charitable dispensary.

Today the "clinic" has developed into a diverse community health programme with an emphasis on health promotion, enabling people to care for their own health with improved awareness through health education, and integrated health and development at the village level. We continue to provide care in our clinics for nearly three thousand persons monthly.

The current programme is a holistic blend of allopathic and homeopathic care/cure offered with loving kindness and compassion to India's most impoverished families and communities. The programme encompasses the following services:

- a general allopathic clinic along with homeopathic clinic
- an allopathic medical practice for the management of tuberculosis, diabetes,
 HIV/AIDS, heart disease and other chronic and complex problems
- a mobile health programme serving villages in remote areas where there are inadequate health services

- an integrated Reproductive and Child Health Programme targeting women and children, offering health promotion, disease prevention, monitoring of growth and development in children
- an integrated, village-based health and development programme which focuses on creating village health committees which consider ways to improve health awareness and health practices in their villages
- a training programme for village health workers and traditional birth attendants
- a computerized data-base tracking patient visits, diagnoses, treatments and progress

Social Programme:

and their participation in social welfare activities for underprivileged schedule caste families has been recognised by the people both as an important resource as well as to emphasis that social problems and social issues require active participation of the community, The policy of the BAHARU HASIMPUR HUMAN WELFARE SOCIETY has been not merely to implement social welfare activities but also to promote, stimulate and develop them and to provide opportunities to train their manpower so that the commitment of community is mobilised for the well-being of the community. The investment in programmes also helps the Organisation to join the mainstream of national concerns and national programmes which are intended for the well-being of the under-privileged sections of society.

Book Distribution to Poor Student:

We recognize education as the main instrument that empowers individuals to make informed choices, resist subjugation & claim their rights, besides opening new possibilities & opportunities for themselves. The philosophy of our organization is based on the belief that each child deserves an equal opportunity for total development. With this belief we have distributed school bags to the poor students to encourage them for their study.

Training Programme:

Under this project, various training programmes have been conducted for the capacity-building and skill development of the rural people. All the trainings are need based, resourced based and location specific. Glimpses of such training programmes are given below:

Training for rural people can be diverse in nature – the main aim is to strengthen their skills and labour to increase their productivity and income of marginalized households. Gender ameliorative training, on the other hand, aims at building capacities of women in the conventional entrepreneurship training but not their position vis-à-vis men. Such ameliorative training based on an acceptance of existing social structures and traditional development objective aims at capacitating women the techno-managerial aspects of micro enterprises and thereby improving their economic condition but leave social issues such as how to deal with male resistance / oppression within the families and in the markets or exploitation by middlemen touched.

The approach seeks to integrate the society into development efforts through such measures as improving their skills, increasing their access to credit, land etc.

Notable Day Celebration:

In this year we have observed the birthdays of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, Rabindranath Tagore, Gandhiji, Swami Vivekananda and Netaji Subhas Ch. Bose and the notable days like World Environment Day, Independence Day and Republic Day to make the beneficiaries and the people understand the significant of remarkable Days and its importance in our day to day life for Nation Building.
